## Compassion Camp VBS



Session 1: June 18-20




Day 1: We have our board game design class that uses art, problem-solving, math, probability, and statistics to teach the children why board games are designed the way they are. They also get to design their own games!

Day 2 is our creative writing course. This class is dedicated to teaching the kids what makes a good story, it explains the theory of 7 stories, and we talk about genres of writing. The kids will then get to write their own stories based on a prompt, have the chance to share them and have them constructively critiqued by the group.

Day 3 is our STEM class. We cover all types of topics, I have modules for engineering, environmental, mechanical, physics, physical science, geology, upcycling, and more. This course is very hands-on with a ton of activities!

This camp is led by Carl Jarman.




